MORNING & EVENING DUAS

The Prophet Muhammad (Peace be upon him) highly encouraged, and he himself practiced the constant remembrance of Allah. Due to the importance of certain forms of remembrance of Allah, we see that the Prophet (peace be upon him) used to constantly repeat some supplications every morning and every evening. These supplications are often referred to as the morning and evening supplications, or the daily adhkar

The morning and evening supplications carry great meanings and provide a formidable source of protection. In addition to the fact that they allow us to feel the presence of Allah with us every day, they also provide us with peace and tranquility, remind us of the importance of certain actions, teach us about Allah, and put us in a frame of mind that allows us to continue our day in a way that pleases Allah.

The optimum time of reciting these supplications is at dawn before sunrise, and at dusk before sunset, as Allah says in the Qur'an

O believers! Always remember Allah often, and glorify Him morning and evening
