- (1) All prize winners should groom themselves with a decent hair cut, and the beard and the mustache well shaved. **This will be strictly enforced.**
- (2) Dress Code
 - (a) The prize winners who are studying in the classes in grade 9 and below should wear a long sleeved white shirt, white shorts, black shoes, white socks and the college tie.
 - (b) The prize winners from classes in Grade 10 and above should wear a white shirt with long sleeves (folded). white trousers, black shoes and the college tie.
 - (c) The prize winners who are no longer attending college must wear a long sleeved white shirt with the college tie, black trousers and black shoes.
- (3) To verify identity, current students must present their Student Record Book, while prize winners who are no longer attending school are required to produce their National Identity Card.
- (4) All Prize Winners must enter through the Junior Gate.
- (5) The prize winners <u>must</u> register between 10:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.
- (6) Prize Winners must register themselves at the Registration Desks at the Grade 6 Classrooms.

- (7) All the invitees are requested to be in their seats by **12.30 p.m.** Please note that no individual is permitted to enter the hall after **12.00 p.m.**
- (8) Smoking is strictly prohibited.
- (9) The Guests are requested to remain in their seats till the end of the proceedings of the ceremony.
- (10) Parents of the prize winners will **not be allowed** to attend the event.
